DOMVS ROMANA

Encounter exquisite mosaics and an Emperor's family when you visit the archaeological remains of a noble Roman townhouse (domvs). Learn about the private life and habits of an ancient Roman aristocrat, ranging from the division of roles in a Roman family to fashion, education, entertainment, and food and drink. Accidentally discovered in 1881, this site had the first ever purposely-built structure in the Maltese Islands meant to protect an archaeological site and collection within it.

ST PAUL'S CATACOMBS

Descend into the underground necropolis in the bowels of the ancient city of Melite. Serving as a burial ground from Punic, Roman, and Byzantine times, St Paul's Catacombs represent the earliest and largest archaeological evidence of Christianity in Malta. The association with the saint derives from the myth that this cluster of catacombs was once connected with St Paul's Grotto.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY

Housed in a stellar location in an 18th-century palace within the fortified city of Mdina, the National Museum of Natural History contains almost 1 million specimens in its collections. Highlights include a flying squid washed ashore in the 1980s, a 4000-year-old mummified Nile crocodile, the skull of a False Killer Whale Pseudorca crassidens, the fossilised head of a Crocodilian Tomistoma gaudense, found in Gozo's rocks and the tooth of the Giant White Shark Carcharocles megalodon.

MALTA MUSEUM OF FOOTBALL

Discover the heart of Maltese football with a visit to the National Stadium and the captivating Football History Museum. Immerse yourself in the rich tapestry of Malta's football heritage, exploring a unique collection of artefacts and memorabilia that celebrate the game's most memorable moments and the legends who have made their mark. From clubs to players, coaches, and officials, journey through the milestones that have shaped Maltese football. Open Monday to Friday, 10am to 4pm (excluding Public Holidays), located at Level 2, Millennium Stand, National Stadium, Ta' Qali. Don't miss this opportunity to walk through the home of Maltese football and relive the glory of the sport's local history.
